Amanda White is a coloratura soprano based in Manhattan. Some of her recent roles include Marie in *La Fille du Régiment* with Champagne and Candlelight Opera di Camera, Adele in *Die Fledermaus* and Madame Herz in *Der Schauspieldirektor* with American Landmark Festivals, and Serpina in *La Serva Padrona*, Nedda in *Pagliacci*, and Bastienne in *Bastien und Bastienne* with Capitol Opera Harrisburg. A frequent interpreter of the Gilbert and Sullivan heroines, she has sung both Mabel and Kate in *The Pirates of Penzance*, Rose Maybud in *Ruddigore*, Aline in *The Sorcerer*, and both Gianetta and Casilda in *The Gondoliers*. An extremely versatile singer, White sings in the choir of the Church of the Holy Apostles under the direction of David Hurd, and has recorded and toured as a singer-songwriter.
